

**SOUTH CENTRAL
KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION
Monday, August 20, 2007**

South Central Elementary will have Kindergarten Orientation for incoming students on Monday, August 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. The first full day of Kindergarten will be Tuesday, August 21st. In previous years, students came in for Orientation at the end of the school year when class sections were not yet established. Most of the students did not meet their correct teacher or even visit the classroom they would be entering.

A parent (grandparent or guardian) should bring their child to school at 9:00 a.m. and plan to stay through Orientation until around 10:30 a.m. By starting later in the morning, many other first-day problems can be solved and the hallways will be much calmer. Due to limited space, we would appreciate only one adult per student. Please bring their school supplies that day also. Questions and concerns about Kindergarten can be answered and communication between home and school can be established.
